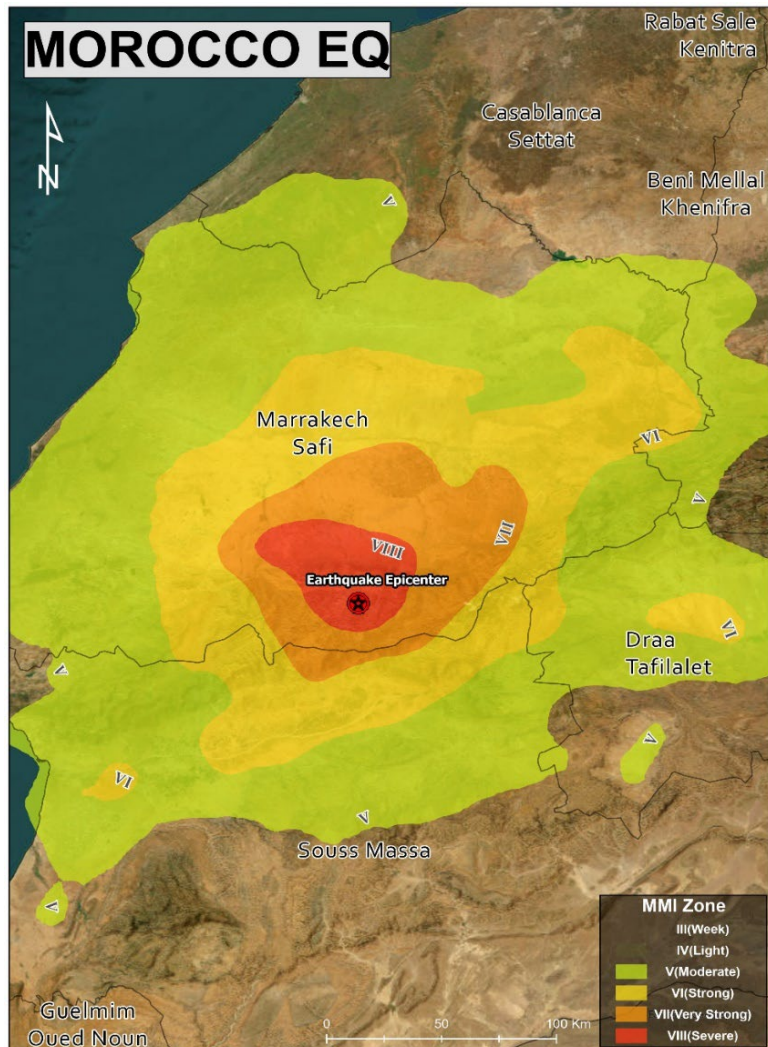


Situation Report

Morocco M6.8 Earthquake 2023



DAMAGE FORECAST

- Mw 6.8 earthquake, **43.5 miles south of Marrakech** (epicentre=31.1 N 8.4 W, depth=18km) on 8 Sept. 2023, 11:11pm local time (GMT +1).
- Estimated **940,000 people** subjected to strong motion (over **200,000 households**).
- Expected **500,000** internally displaced persons (IDPs).
- Fatalities estimated at over **5,000 (2,800 confirmed)**, injuries estimated over **15,000**.
- **60,000+ structures** (homes) exposed to strong motion, damage index estimated at **20% heavy, 30% moderate damage**.
