

**Morocco M6.8 Earthquake 2023** 



Update #1 13 September 2023



## **DAMAGE FORECAST**

- Mw 6.8 earthquake, 43.5 miles south of Marrakech (epicentre=31.1 N 8.4 W, depth=18km) on 8 Sept. 2023, 11:11pm local time (GMT +1).
- Estimated 800,000 people subjected to strong motion (over 200,000 households).
- Expected 500,000 internally displaced persons (IDPs).
- Fatalities estimated at over 5,000 (2,800 confirmed), injuries estimated over 15,000.
- 60,000+ structures (homes) exposed to strong motion, damage index estimated at 20% heavy, 30% moderate damage.
